

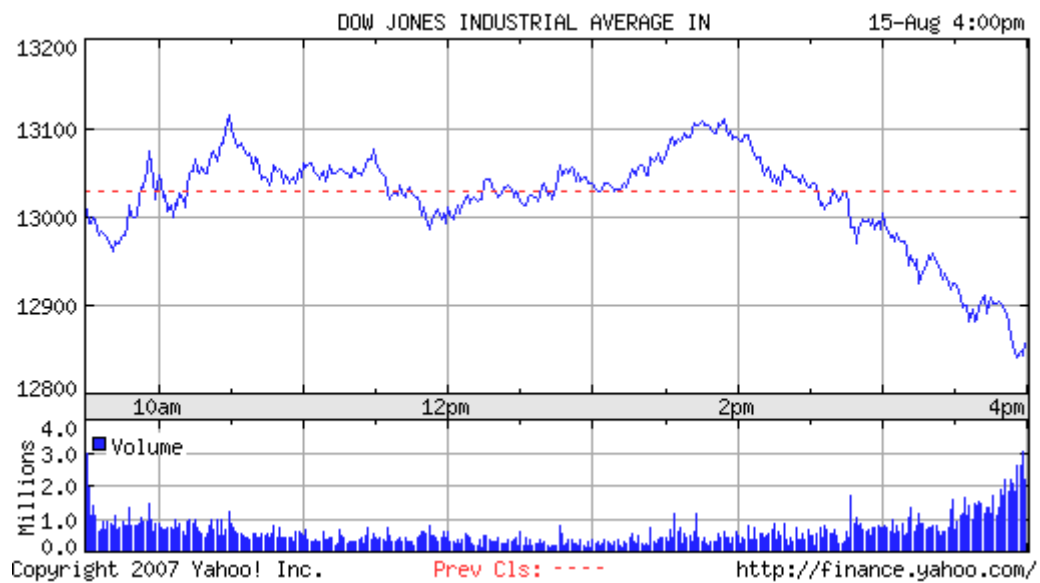

Petraeus says he will propose troop cuts

US stock markets were rattled today after US General Petraeus had said at 2.15 PM ET that he would propose troop cuts and believes the U.S. footprint in Iraq will have to be "a good bit smaller" by next summer. Before stock markets had found support by the news that the United States were preparing an Iran Guard 'terrorist' report, because the number of the victims of a suicide attack in Iraq rose to 250 and because stocks were helped by some central bank interventions.
